### The Pacaya Samiria National Reserve and Peruvian Amazon

Experience leaving the modern world behind and begin your journey of discoverying into one of the world's most remote regions.

Gather on the ship's observation deck and watch as civilization fades away, while the vast Amazon River unfolds. Visiting the mysterious Amazon River basin, one of Earth's most exotic natural realms and our planet's largest rainforest ecosystem, is an unforgettable experience. The longest navigable river, the Amazon, winds more than 4,000 miles from its source in the Andes Mountains to the Atlantic Ocean, and its tributaries fan out over 1.5 million square miles to sustain the lush flora and extraordinary fauna of this fragile environment.

Explore the boundless diversity of nature's most wondrous offering from delicate orchids to transparent glass frogs and pink river dolphins, from the trees of the lush rainforest to the depths of black water tributaries.

In an authentic atmosphere of exploration, beyond the confluence of the Ucayali River and Marañon River – the legendary inception of the Amazon River- where the primeval calls of birds and wildlife echo across the rainforest.

Travel far beyond civilization, navigating black water rivers and walking in remote forests where the numbers of butterfly species climbs into the thousands, and many species have yet to be classified or even discovered.

On your expedition vessel, an expert Peruvian naturalist will lead you through the rainforest to see rare indigenous species and guide you down the Amazon's secretive, sinuous tributaries aboard special small excursion boats. You will also visit local villages to gain insight into the traditional way of life of the river people (people who live in the river) and see a shaman perform an ancient ritual at Pacaya Samiria National Reserve and Peruvian Amazon


## Navigation map

### Amazon Conservation

In addition to our efforts for the conservation of the Amazon and its resources, we are now partners and actively collaborate with **Amazon Forever** and **Amazon Forever BioPark**, a non-profit organization that promotes the conservation of white sand forests and other Amazon ecosystems through positive contact with nature, education, research, and the preservation of wildlife.

Another important contribution is our support for the **Association for the Conservation of Amazonian Biodiversity (ACOBIA)**; where we collaborate with a donation for the execution of their activities.

Our guides have a relationship of more than 20 years with the Peruvian Amazon and they will lead you to a unique connection with all forms of life and cultures that give a meaningful shape to a region that breathes life.







#### **RATE EXCLUSIONS**

- Domestic flights
- Cost of medical emergencies (including evacuation).
- Gratuities: we suggest a tip amount of USD 20 to USD 25 per passenger per night for the crew (which will be divided among all crew members) and a tip amount of USD 7 to USD 10 per passenger per night for the guides. Please note that these amounts are suggested and that this is entirely at the discretion of our guests.
- Any additional transportation services.
- Any additional bar consumptions.

#### **IMPORTANT**

- Rates are expressed in US Dollars, per person, based on double occupancy.
- Charter: Pricing for custom-designed charters are quoted according to your specific request and needs.
- The supplement for single occupancy in a cabin is 30% of the regular adult fare. For superior cabins, an additional 50% will apply to the adult fare. Cabins 4 and 6 are excluded from the single occupancy supplement.
- Child policy: the recommended age is 7 years old + on all departures. Children aged 7 to 11 years old are eligible for a 50% discount from the adult rate. Children must be accompanied by one or two adults per cabin. The capacity is of one child per cabin.

### **Terms & Conditions**

#### **BOOKING POLICY**

- For all registered travel agents, we offer the benefit of holding tentative departures without prepayment for a maximum of 7 days. Exclusive benefit only for FITS reservations.
- For Confirmed Bookings: A deposit of US\$ 500 per person is required to confirm the booking. For reservations made 90 days or less prior to departure, a full, non- refundable payment is required to confirm the booking.

#### **FITS RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS**

- Reservations made 90 days or less prior to departure: A full, non-refundable payment is required to confirm the booking.
- Reservations made 91 days or more before departure: A deposit of US\$ 500 per person is required to confirm the booking. The final balance is required 90 days prior to departure. If the payment is not received on time, the space(s) will be automatically released.

#### **GROUP RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS (8 PAX OR MORE)**

For Reservations made 121 days or more prior to departure:

- An initial deposit of US\$ 500 per person is required to confirm the booking, with a second deposit of US\$ 500 per person 120 days before departure. The final balance is required 90 days prior to departure.
- For Reservations made 120 days to 91 days prior to departure: A deposit of US\$ 1,000 per person is required to confirm the booking. The final balance is required 90 days prior to departure.
- For Reservations made 90 days or less prior to departure: A full, non-refundable payment is required to confirm the booking.

#### **CANCELATION POLICY**

For Cancelations made 121 days or more prior to departure:

- The deposit will be refunded, minus US \$200 service charge per person.
- For Cancelations made 120 to 91 days prior to departure: All deposits are non-refundable.
- For Cancelations made 90 days or less prior to departure: Full payment will be applied as the cancelation penalty.

In the following case of "Force Majeure", Jungle Experiences can reschedule the trip at no additional cost:

- Events that directly affect the operation of the cruises and prevent sailing, for example:
- An outbreak of infectious or contagious diseases/virus deemed a global epidemic or pandemic by the World Health Organization
- Events of political unrest and social manifestations.

### **DEPARTURE DATE CHANGE POLICY**

- Jungle Experiences permits guests to change the departure date of their cruise at least 181 days prior to their original date of departure without penalty.
- A fee of US\$500 per person will be applied for date changes made between 180 and 121 days prior to departure. No date changes are permitted within 120 days from departure.

#### NAME CHANGE POLICY

- Jungle Experiences permits guests to change their names to other travelers' names up to 60 days prior departure date, without penalty.
- In case there is a change of name requested 59 days or less prior departure date, there will be a USD 200 penalty charge per person.

#### **VESSEL REPLACEMENT POLICY**

• Jungle Experiences reserves the right to substitute another vessel if considered necessary (i.e force majeure or mechanical failure). If the travelers do not take this option, Jungle Experiences reserves the right to cancel the trip upon a refund pro rata per cruise night not used or, as an alternative, will offer credit toward a future cruise.
